Elayne LaPorta supports ARTSWALK and children's art education outreach and is open to the public during most Third Thursday events.. Elayne loves to meet visitors and discuss her art. We guarantee you will leave her gallery with a new appreciation of color, heightened sensitivity, and a stimulated imagination. Please don't rush through this art space, but take time to ponder the story within each image. Great care, thought, and attention to detail command her work.

Known for her detailed folk paintings, Elayne LaPorta's palette is filled with colors inspired by dramatic themes from the Bible. She has found her niche translating spiritual scenes onto oils and prints. Using a unique American folk concept Elayne calls, "Naïveté," she has developed a unique relationship to biblical art and artistic expression. A student of archeology and a scholar of historical commentary, Elayne evokes strong details to create a deep connection to the subjects she paints. Extensive research and detailed knowledge of her subject lay the groundwork for each image. She often travels to study the terrain and history that supports her investigation. The result is a visual narrative that depicts the vegetation, clothing, weapons, and legends indigenous to particular biblical themes.

SUNI PAZ, singer, songwriter, poet, educator, author and presenter, has devoted her life to children and their families.

She has thrilled worldwide audiences of all ages on stage, television and radio with her stories in song accompanied on guitar, charango and percussive instruments.

Born in Argentina, in 1965 she moved to the United States with her children. She received a Master's degree at Rutgers University in Hispano American Literature, a grant from the Center for International Education-Fulbright-Atlas-Tinker Foundation, a Parent's Choice Award through Smithsonian Folkways and the Magic Penny Award from the Children's Music Network.

She has recorded and published more than 300 songs, and set to music the lyrics of award winning poets and writers Alma Flor Ada and Isabel Campoy. In 2007, Suni published her memoirs in Spanish *Destellos y Sombras* and in English, *Sparkles and Shadows*. She contributed five poems to a book entitled *La inefable locura de ser poeta*. Next June 2010 one of Suni Paz's stories is coming out in a book created by Terry Laszlo Gopadze entitled *The Spirit of a Woman, Intimate Stories to Empower and Inspire*. Suni believes in the art and power of music and words to change, inspire and heal.



Suni volunteers to share her music with our visiting artists during the Third Thursday ARTsWALK each month. You will enjoy her music and come away with a lighter heart. Her message for the children is one of joy and happiness. They play percussion instruments and learn songs to practice until the next time we get together to share art and friendship.
