**NOTE: ENTRIES MUST NOT BE WIDER THAN 20 FEET AND NO TALLER THAN 17 FEET.**  
(Motorized car clubs/motorized group cars must not be longer than 300 feet in length.)

- Thank you for participating in the Children's WinterFest Parade on Saturday, December 13, 2008.
  - The Parade Theme is:** "Toys on Parade".
  - Parade will start promptly at 10:00 a.m.
  - The parade staging area will be at Ocean Avenue and Water Street.
  - Entries to be staged in their designated space by 09:00 AM.

(All Entries are strongly encouraged to incorporate the parade theme "Toys on Parade" into their entry, especially since this year's Grand Marshal will be the US Marine Corp celebrating the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of their Toys for Tots program. Entries are also encouraged to gear their entry towards more walking participation and will the parade route has been adjusted to accommodate – Route will be along Water Street from Ocean Avenue to Pacific Avenue)
- In order to lend additional color and flavor to the occasion, and to increase spectator appeal, the Committee has established a minimum decoration requirement:
  - All autos and trucks must be decorated from window down (except special industrial equipment, antique autos and special interest autos)
  - ENTRIES MUST NOT BE WIDER THAN 20 FEET OR NO TALLER THAN 17 FEET.
  - Motorized car clubs/motorized group cars must not be longer than 300 feet in length.
  - You may display any number of suitable identifying cards relating to your business or organization.
  - In order for the announcers/commentators to identify your entry, your entry number must be displayed.
  - All entries will be inspected in the parade staging area. If the entry does not meet these requirements, it will be disqualified from the parade.**
- Absolutely NO objects may be thrown from the parade entries. No alcohol will be allowed in the parade staging area or is to be consumed or carried by the parade participants during the parade. Violators will be disqualified by parade officials. All participants must be dressed in FAMILY ACCEPTABLE dress code. Also, there will be NO Water Guns, Water Balloons or Spraying of Water from entries and please remember Santa will be a special guest in the parade with the U.S. Marine Corp and we request, PLEASE No Other "actual" Santas incorporated within the Parade. Santa decorations are allowed.**
- All entries must move in a forward line of march / direction.**
- Your parade number and staging area map MUST be picked up at the Henderson Convention Center, 200 S. Water Street. Numbers / Area Maps will be available Monday, December 8TH through Friday, December 12th from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.**
- Attention Marching Groups and Drill teams:** Please keep pace with the parade procession. There will be parade monitors stationed along the parade route to help maintain uniform spacing.
- Attention Equestrian Entries:** Twenty-four hours prior to the parade, please keep your horses off hay or green pasture in consideration of the marching groups. Each Equestrian Entry must provide one clean-up crew member who is responsible for marching behind the horse(s) for immediate clean-up if necessary.
- Awards to follow at the Henderson Events Plaza at approximately 2pm. Winners not present will be notified on Tuesday, December 16th, 2008, by telephone. Please be sure to have your correct phone number on application.**
- Parade judges will be looking for the best incorporation of the parade theme into your entry and for the most unique costume depicting the parade theme. REMEMBER: "Toys On Parade" is this year's theme. Entries are eligible to win one of the two prizes offered – Entries not eligible to win both.

## Toys on Parade Rules:

1. Check in and line-up will be between 8:00 am and 9:00 am. **ALL ENTRIES NEED TO BE READY TO GO BY 9:30 a.m. including all hand-outs.**
2. **Absolutely NO objects may be thrown from the parade entries. No alcohol will be allowed in the parade staging area or is to be consumed or carried by the parade participants during the parade. Violators will be disqualified by parade officials. All participants must be dressed in FAMILY ACCEPTABLE dress code. Also, there will be NO Water Guns, Water Balloons or Spraying of Water from entries.**
3. **All entries must move in a forward line of march direction.**
4. **Attention Horse Entries:** Twenty-four hours prior to the parade, please keep your horses off hay or green pasture in consideration of the marching groups. All horse entries will line up on the west side of Ocean Avenue. Each entry must provide one clean-up crew member who is responsible for marching behind the horse(s) for immediate clean-up if necessary.
5. **All competitive entries must be of amateur status. Professionally built entries (rented costumes) will be considered non-competitive.**
6. **Awards to follow at Henderson Events Plaza at 2 p.m. on the Amphitheater stage. Winners not present will be notified on Tuesday, December 16, 2008, by telephone. We encourage all entries to stick around for the awards ceremony and all other festivities.**
